With reference to the correspondence coming with your letter dated 2.8.1976 in the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi to grant provisional recognition to your school as a Middle School (Classes VI to VIII) without grant-in-aid up to 30.4.1977 (30-4-1977) subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- 1) The school should construct a building of its own within a period of two years. The present rented accommodation should be improved and expanded in accordance with needs. A progress report may be sent by 31.3.1977.
- 2) A sum of Rs.6000/- should be spent during 1976-77 to improve library, lab. and extra curricular activities. A progress Report should be submitted by 31.3.1977.
3. Lavatory and drinking water facilities should be improved.
4. The enrolment of the school should be improved.
5. The land allotted to the school by Government of India in the name of primary school may be got allotted for Middle school as one composite unit.
6. The school should submit within three months the documentary proof regarding the permanent source of income along with audited statements from Chartered Accountant for the last two years.
7. The furniture should be provided to all the students in all classes in the school.
8. The staff should be paid scales of pay and total emoluments equivalent to those paid to their counter parts in Govt. schools.
9. Arrangements may be made for teaching the students in all the classes through medium of Hindi.
10. The school should comply with the provisions of Delhi Education Act 1973 and rules framed thereunder.

The Management of the school will submit a compliance report before 31.3.1977.

With reference to your application on the subject noted above, approval for the upgradation of the existing Middle School to Secondary level is granted with effect from 1984-85 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provision of Delhi School Education Act & Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff for all the classes of the school as per the present norms of the department. Additional staff shall be provided for Secondary classes immediately.
4. That the school shall equip the Science Labs as per the norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students and Science material/equipment worth Rs.5,000/- may be purchased immediately.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student shall be provided. Books worth Rs.3,000/- may be purchased immediately.
6. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Sec.10(1) of the Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973.
8. That the enrolment in section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the classroom and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation, as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing classrooms of proper size in the school.

That the school shall not run any unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery class be removed from the premises of the school, if any.

That the school shall dispense with the service of unqualified and overaged staff, if any, immediately.

That the scheme of management shall be got approved from the Department immediately.

That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.

That all facilities prescribed under the Rules 50 and 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.

That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the local body within a month.

That the management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs.10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand Only).

That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.

1. That the management of the school shall immediately apply for affiliation with Secretary, CBSE for affiliation through Education Officer concerned.

2. That a report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled, shall be sent to the Education Officer every six month.

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school will meet the additional liability of senior secondary classes.
4. That the school shall establish and equip all the three Science Labs. as per the norms of the department/CBSE and apply separately for the introduction of science for the permission only.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student may be added.
6. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of section 10(i) of the Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973, and payment shall be made through crossed cheque.
8. That the enrolment of each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing class-rooms of proper size in the school and each class-room, science lab. and library rooms may be fitted with proper electrical appliances.
9. That the school shall not run any unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and

all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery classes be removed from the premises of the school immediately. That the school shall obtain the fresh Health Certificate from the M.C.D.

10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.

11. That the service contract between the management and the employee shall be executed immediately.

12. That all the facilities prescribed under rule 50 & 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.

13. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the Local Body within a month.

14. That the Management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) only in the name of Director of Education and the Manager of the school.

15. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.

16. That the school society shall obtain land from the DDA and will construct the building as per the specifications of the Department within a period of three years.

In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining loan/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on details/data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

1. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and Instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
2. The School is required to apply online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
3. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III Issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer
4. The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
5. The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
6. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
7. Admission to the school is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.

11. The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc




